

## Biblical Philosophy

With the Word of God (the Authorized King James Version) as the final authority, NCA is committed to assisting the two institutions ordained by God, the home and the local church, in fulfilling their responsibility to the youth of today. The primacy of the home and family is basic to the philosophy of NCA. Our commitment is to help parents in their appointed task of raising and training their children in the fear and admonition of the Lord. We therefore established NCA Daycare as a ministry of First Bible Baptist Church.

Northstar Preschool and Daycare is a Bible based classroom where the Bible is taught and practiced throughout the year. Our goal is to perfect the Christ like qualities in the lives of our students so that they grow up "in the nurture and admonition of the Lord".



# Day Care / Preschool

## What We Teach

Northstar daycare/preschool teaches from the ABEKA curriculum, which is based on letter recognition, writing and phonetic sounds to each letter. The 3-year-old program is a wonderful introduction to a fun filled learning environment. All of our classes are teacher directed.

Our 4-year-old program introduces the 5 vowels and then pairs them with a consonant to form blends, which the children have fun forming into three letter words. This creates an excellent reading environment for your child. Along with letter recognition, your child will be taught number recognition and number writing,. We incorporate counting by 2's and 5's with the use of songs and finger play. Our circle time is full of learning including the days of the week, months of the year, opposites, shapes, and colors. We practice very important social skills everyday such as sharing, how to be a good friend, respecting others, but most importantly how to respect our self.

A Progress report is sent home in January to let you know how your child is doing. A follow up is done at the end of the year. It is very important that we communicate on a regular basis. Any changes made in the classroom or with the center will be sent home in writing, therefore it is very important that you read all notices and news letters sent home.

# Day Care / Preschool

## Program Rates 2022-2023

You can fill out a paper application from the Office, or you can go online at [www.northstardaycare.com](http://www.northstardaycare.com) and fill out a registration form online.

### Day Care Program

#### Preschool Program

Pre-K begins in September, the same day NCA begins classes for K-12th grades, and ends in May/ June.

Preschool hours are 9 am to 11:30 am.

**Pre-School Payment is due the first day of class each month.**

Three (3) morning Pre-K is \$250.00/month

Five (5) morning Pre-K is \$375.00/month

*Please note that checks will normally be deposited within 5 business days, but could possibly take up to 14 business days.*

**Daycare children are part of our pre-k program with no additional charge.**

Daycare payment is due the Friday prior to the week of care.

Daycare programs run on a year round calendar.

All Day childcare if 4 days or less....\$55.00 per day

Half Day 7am-12pm.....\$30.00 per day

5 full time days....\$240.00 per week

**Payments may be handed to any one on Staff at NCA Daycare.** Please request a receipt if you are paying in cash.

### **Admission and Fees**

The annual **registration fee of \$40.00 per child** and \$10 for each additional child is due with the registration papers. The fee is nonrefundable. Your registration payment assures your child's placement in our program. A new registration must be submitted for September of each year.

The annual Field trip fee of \$30.00 and the key card deposit of \$10/key card is payable upon registration for our daycare and preschool programs. Please note that it may take at least 2 full business days before your child can start in our program. This will allow time to review the paperwork submitted and to clear any questions we may have.

At the time of registration, be prepared to pay the registration fee, field trip fee, key card deposit, a payment of one week's dues, and include all paperwork

**All weekly accounts must be paid on Friday, prior to the week of care.**

If your account is in arrears your child may not return to our program until payment is made.

**A weekly late fee of \$5.00 may be charged to any account with an outstanding balance.**

When you make a commitment for childcare in the PK3 or PK4 Daycare program, or the Preschool program, **you are responsible for payment even if your child isn't in attendance.**

## SCHOOL AGE CARE

Your child will be in a well-balanced Christian atmosphere with teachers who love working with children. Our center provides a close-knit After School program, along with all day care during school vacation breaks. Your child will have the opportunity to play with educational toys, do science experiments, show their creativity through inventive arts and crafts, and play fun filled games both indoors and outdoors. We also provide devotional readings and discussion, as well as a time set aside for homework. Your child will be in a well-balanced Christian atmosphere with teachers who love working with children.

Time on electronics is limited per child, per day. Our teachers are hands-on at all times and are always looking for new and exciting things to do. We have a beautiful playground right outside our back door, and if it's too cold or rainy, we make use of the spaces available to us inside. We strive for personal interaction through physical and social activities. In the event we allow electronics, we have access to computers, tv, and much more. If you send electronics or any other items in from home please be aware that it is at your own risk.

Registration fee: **\$40.00**

Before/After school care: **5 day Weekly \$75**  
Or **\$15/ Day**

**Vacation Breaks:** **\$35/Day** or  
**\$175.00** weekly

The annual **registration fee of \$40.00 per child** and \$10 for each additional child is due with the registration papers. The fee is nonrefundable. Your registration payment assures your child's placement in our program. A new registration must be submitted for September of each year. # Preschool / Daycare / School Age Guidelines




## Illness

1. If your child(ren) should become ill during the day you will be notified to pick them up promptly. We expect that your child will be picked up within an hour.

**Your child may not return to the center until he/she has been free from symptoms for 24 hours.**

In case of contagious or infectious diseases, a doctor's note may be required.

2. Use discretion when having your child return to school. Please only send them when they are ready.
3. A child may return to the center with these illnesses as follows:
  - A. Chicken Pox: when all blisters have developed scabs. The scabs need not all be gone.
  - B. Hand, Foot & Mouth: 7 days after the last new blister appears. All blisters need to be scabbed.
  - C. Pink Eye: 24 hours after starting antibiotics
  - D. Croup: Three days after the cough begins.
4. Keep your child home if they have a fever or has had one during the **previous 24-hour** period, a heavy nasal discharge or has a constant cough.
5. Please notify the center if your child may have a communicable disease: Symptoms of a possible communicable disease are usually sniffles, reddened eyes, sore throat, headache and abdominal pain, plus a fever.
6. Children will not be allowed to attend the center with a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, rash of unknown origin, or any other communicable disease until the child is free from symptoms for 24 hours. *This is subject to the director's discretion.*



## Security Key Card

As we are a secured building, you need to obtain key cards for each person that will be dropping off or picking up your child each day. Each key card requires a \$10.00 refundable deposit that will be returned upon surrender of each working key card.

In the event that you misplace or forget your key card, you may enter the building through the main entrance of the school. If a key card is lost, please inform the office and your deposit is forfeited and an additional deposit is required for a new key card.

## **Behavior and Tolerance Policy**

Our goal is to teach self-discipline. We are a teacher directed center. In most cases, the teachers will handle minor behaviors in the classroom through redirection. You will be notified by the center if your child's behavior needs your attention. The center will work with you to try to change your child's behavior within the classroom, however if this is not possible the center reserves the right to dismiss the child. We have a responsibility to offer a safe and positive environment to all of our children within the center. If the behavior escalates into an unsafe situation for other students or teachers and we are unable to correct the negative behavior, your child may be asked to leave our program.

## **Children's Rights and Responsibilities**

All children have the right to a safe and healthy environment, with equal use of equipment, and attention. All children are encouraged to express their feelings and thoughts in an appropriate manner. Every child will be treated with respect, and staff will have an individualized understanding of each child.

Children are expected to treat others how they would want to be treated. Equipment, toys, and material provided by our facility should be kept in good condition. School aged children are old enough to decipher between, "good choice," and "bad choice." This concept is what we encourage the children to use while interacting with others, as well as while personal decision making.

## **Clothing**

Please make sure your child is dressed in comfortable attire that is easily washed, as we are very involved with crafting, outdoor play etc. Please dress children weather appropriate. Northstar Christian Academy Daycare is not responsible for lost or damaged clothing or belongings.

For School Age Care please send in a change of clothes and footwear if you do not want them playing in their NCA uniform.

## **Emergency Closings**

Any late openings or closings will be announced through our text system, email and on local news media including Facebook, and our website, Northstardaycare.com. When you listen for school closings and only hear that Northstar Christian Academy is closed, the NCA Daycare will be open. The Daycare is only closed when you hear that the Northstar Christian Daycare is closed. **In all instances the preschool program will always be closed when the school is closed.**

## **Holidays & Closings**

You are responsible for your weekly daycare fee each week including any holidays that the center may be closed with the exception of a shut down week with dates to be announced. Please refer to the provided school calendar for these dates.

## **Hours and Late Fees**

There will be a **late fee of \$5 per child, for every five minutes you are late** in picking up after the designated pick up time and or closing time. Please see the Director if you have any questions or concerns regarding this policy.

## **Medication Policy**

Prescription and orally-administered over-the-counter medication may be administered only with written permission of the parent and written instructions from a health care provider stating that the daycare provider may administer such medication or prescription and specifying the circumstances. Medication must be in the original container labeled with the child's complete name, the medication name, recommended dosage, time intervals for administration, method of administration, expiration date. For prescription medication, the prescriber's name and license number must also be written along with the above mentioned for all medications.

## **Outdoor Policy**

Children will have an opportunity to play outside at least 15 minutes, per day, weather permitting. Please be prepared for your child to go outside, even in the winter.

## **Pick-up Authorization**

People authorized to pick up your child have been submitted by you on your registration form. Persons without photo id will not be able to pick your child up. All persons authorized to pickup must be at least 16 years old. If there is a custody agreement in place, we ask that the court order is provided to our center. If a parent not authorized to pick up the child on a day they are not authorized, we will contact authorities and the other parent.

## **Returned Check Policy**

There will be a \$30.00 surcharge for all returned checks. You have one week in which to make repayment. After a second returned check we will only accept cash or money orders for the remainder of the year. We cannot accept any out of state checks as payment on an account.

## **Snacks and Lunches**

We ask that you please pack a Healthy Lunch and 2 snacks. One for morning snack and one for afternoon snack.

School age snacks are provided by center. After School children will be given a snack as they arrive

\*\*Keep in mind, if your child has a food allergy or food preference, we request that you provide their snacks for the day. Any allergy needs to be documented with a note from the doctor's office.

## **Things Not Allowed**

Please be advised that we do not allow certain items in our classroom that portray violence, witchcraft, or the like. We provide plenty of healthy activities for everyone.

## **Toilet Training**

Children in our program need to be toilet trained and self-sufficient in the toileting area. Please provide extra clothing in the event your child has an accident. We can assist your child, but they must be able to dress and undress themselves and be able to meet their personal needs.

## **Termination/Change of Care**

**Any changes for registered children require a two week notice in writing. A verbal notice will not be adequate. This includes children leaving our program or children changing hours of attendance in our program.** Parents who fail to do so will be responsible for payment.

**This does NOT include vacations. You are still responsible for payment vacation weeks.**

NCA Daycare reserves the right to dismiss a child from the program with a two week notice.

When health, welfare and safety of other children are involved, we reserve the right to terminate child care services immediately.
